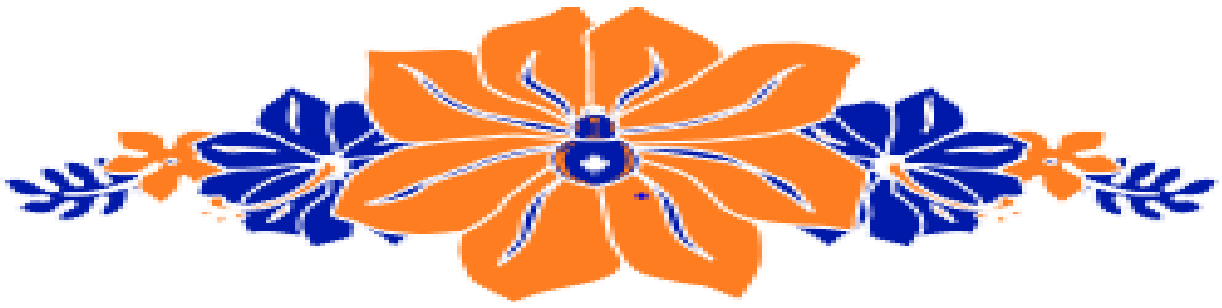
## Kelowna Paddle Centre – Eric Mitchell Coaching Clinics May 3-7
