In accordance with CORA guidelines all participants and volunteers at this event will need to be fully vaccinated.

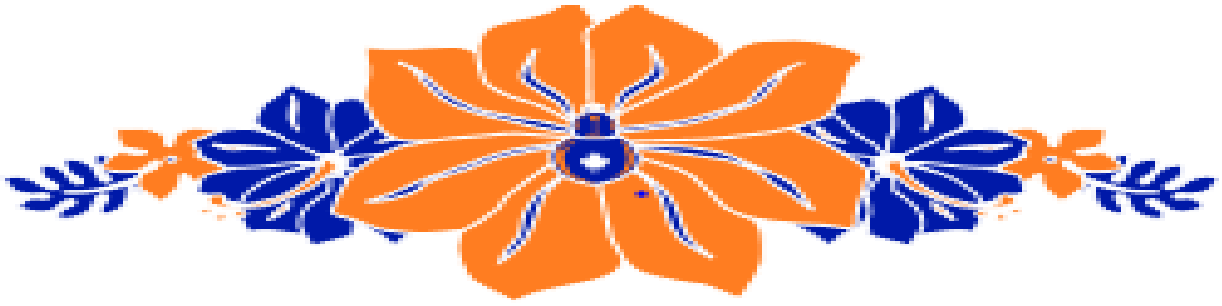
